It determines the atomic mass of atoms. Because protons and neutrons both are baryons, the mass number A is identical with the baryon number B as of the nucleus as of the ...

Example Exercise 9.1 Atomic Mass and Avogadro's Number

A relative atomic mass (also called atomic weight; symbol: A_r) is a measure of how heavy atoms are. It is the ratio of the average mass per atom of an element from a given sample to 1/12 the mass of a carbon-12 atom. In other words, a relative atomic mass tells you the number of times an average atom of an element from a given sample is heavier than one-twelfth of an atom of carbon-12.

The physicist J. J. Thomson measured the mass of cathode rays, showing they were made of particles, but were around 1800 times lighter than the lightest atom, hydrogen. Therefore, they were not atoms, but a new particle, the first subatomic particle to be discovered, which he originally called "corpuscle" but was later named electron, after particles postulated by George Johnstone Stoney in 1874.

Molar Mass for Molecular Compounds . The first step in the determination of the molar mass of a molecular compound is to determine the molecular mass of the compound, which is the weighted average mass of the compound's naturally occurring molecules. This is found by adding the atomic masses of the atoms in each molecule. Molecular mass = the sum of the atomic masses of each atom in the molecule
